

2020 Thornberry Creek High School Golf *P.R.E.P.* Program

Purpose of the Program

To have fun, learning and competing in the game of golf while preparing Green Bay area Junior Golfers for high school competition! Providing instruction, tips, and insight to high school play, including course management, mental game thoughts while competing, rules of golf and etiquette before, during, and after play. Limited to the first 20 juniors! We will form teams to play 9 hole matches during the season, similar to the high school season. Teams will be determined by instructors, and the top 2 teams will compete for “state”

Eligibility:

The program is open to all juniors entering 7th, 8th, and 9th grade in fall of 2020. Juniors must be able to play 9 holes with no concerns and must be able to keep score for another competitor and themselves during matches.

Instructors: The program consists of PGA Professionals and PGA Apprentices.

Cost of the Program: \$300.00 (\$275 if paid by March 15th, 2020)

Entry Fee includes the following:

- Instruction before and during play on the course
- Full Practice Facility use from June 10th thru August 7th
- All Green fees during practice days and matches—7-8 play days throughout the season, plus practices!
- Golf Shirt and other awards throughout the season
- Discounted play opportunities for parents and kids!

- June 10th & 12th Course management—Rules of Golf, Safety and Fundamentals, Mental game
- June 17th & 19th Play 9 holes to determine teams
- June 24th & 26th Practice Session
- July 1st Matches—9 holes each
- July 8th Practice Session
- July 15th Matches—9 holes each
- July 17th Practice Session
- July 22nd Matches—9 holes each
- July 24th Practice Session
- July 29th (Built in rain date) Practice
- July 31st 'Regional' Match (One team eliminated)
- Aug. 5th 'Sectional' Match (One team eliminated)
- Aug. 7th State Match'

Attendance: While perfect attendance may not be possible, we ask that every effort goes in to attending each practice session or match. We will form 4 teams and all juniors will play, but will count 4 out of the 5 scores each match.

Bad Weather Days: Due to the short season and full schedule, we will be unable to reschedule any missed weeks or canceled sessions due to weather.
